for the

The Executive Committee has reviewed the information available in relation to holding the event at this campsite. In addition there is a strong perception that there is a high risk associated with holding this event at Britannia Park. As a result the Executive Committee has decided that the event should be relocated from Britannia Park to Marcus Oldham College in Geelong.

Girl Guides Victoria will be working closely with the Planning Committee to provide support and guidance for this event given the short timeframe to implement the elements associated with the change of venue.
